Gibney Dance will perform **View Partially Obstructed** at l'AGORA DE LA DANSE, in Montreal, Canada, on February 25, 26 and 27. A benefit night, with proceedings donated to La Dauphinelle, a Montreal-based domestic violence shelter, will open the festivities and at the same time mark the official launch of the **Dance Against Violence** project.

Created with the involvement of champion Amelie Dionne-Charest, this project was developed in partnership with Gibney Dance, Montreal Danse, La Dauphinelle and l'Agora de la Danse. Last November, as a preliminary step to this project, our dancers went to Montreal for a 1-week training residency, during which they passed on their expertise in working with survivors of domestic violence to the members of Montreal Danse.
